State Champion Brewer: Stephen Tully 10 points

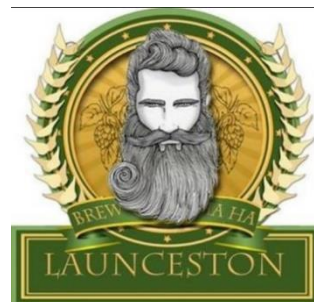
Honourable Mentions: Keith Larkin and Julian Dykman 8 points each

Beers are placed First, Second or Third. When scores are tied, placings are decided by progressive count back as detailed in the Competition rules

- **Gold Standard:** Beers that score 120+ points out of 150 are rated as Gold Standard (Excellent to Outstanding for the style).
- **Silver Standard:** applies to beers that score between 105 and less than 120 points (Very good to excellent for the style)
- **Bronze Standard:** applies to beers that score between 90 and less than 105 points (Very good for the style)
